Rules For Competition

Three divisions will be held to determine placings for the Coors HeadQuarters Ranch Futurity.

Each division will be scored from 60 to 80 points and all three scores will be added to determine the placings.

Division 1 – Ranch Riding

Horses will be asked to walk, trot, short lope and perform an extended lope in both directions. Additionally, horses will be asked to negotiate at least 3 obstacles which may include:

- a) opening and closing a gate with a rider
- b) maneuvering across logs at any gate
- c) ground tying
- d) standing for mounting and dismounting
- e) dragging a log

Division 2 – Reining

Horses will be asked to perform a simple, modified reining pattern.

Division 3 – Cattle Work

Horses will work and hold a cow along a back fence and then drive that cow up the center of the arena between two boundaries.

Entries in the Coors HeadQuarters Futurity are expected to be sound, broke, quiet and athletic.

Entries will not be asked to rope as 3-year-olds.

Entries are not required to be re-sold in a future sale however, an annual sale session will be dedicated to 3-year-olds shown in the Coors HeadQuarters Ranch Futurity.

Rules are subject to change after the 2013 Coors HeadQuarters Ranch Futurity to accommodate a larger number of entries.

Every horse is automatically eligible if it sells and transfers. To increase the purse more, every entry must pay the following one-time entry fee to remain eligible:
